Sibling Contract: Tip Sheet

Expectations for Foster Parents

*In addition to expectations of foster parents as found in DCFS 402 standards and the foster parent's implementation plan

- 🦋 Work as a part of the team for the children. Advocate, Support and participate in all necessary Appointments and case specific meetings.
- 🦋 Take care of health care, education, record keeping and assisting with legal family contact
- 🦋 Participate in 36 hours of continuing education training per year that support skills needed for Working with the youth you work with.

Expectations for Children's Home and Aid

*In addition to expectations of CHA as found in the foster parent's implementation plan

- 🦋 Caseworker will help with timely referral to any necessary services or programs
- 🦋 Provide monthly reimbursement at an increased rate to assist with the added services and Responsibilities of the sibling group
- 🦋 Assist with locating respite options each month. 3 children = 16 hours per month and 4 or More = 24 hours per month
- 🦋 Four face-to-face contacts per month with each child during the first two months of Placement. Two face-to-face contacts per month occur thereafter with at least one within the Foster home.
